paid in full all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or  
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who  
may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of Ten per cent besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be  
added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any  
part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do  
grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Mrs Essie Robinson

And her heirs and assigns forever, the following  
described real estate:  
All that piece, parcel or lot of land, situate, lying  
and being in the State and County aforesaid  
in or near the city of Greenville, and being des-  
ignated as lot number 11, Block C, on a plat of the  
O.P. Mills property made by R.E. Dalton, C.E. May

in plat book C, page 284 and plat Book 9 Page  
171. Fronting on Mission Street, beginning at a  
joint corner of lots 11 and 12 and running thence  
N. 53-18 E, 200 ft. to a point near the rear line of  
lot 21, thence N. 36-50 3/4, 50 feet to the rear point  
corner of lots 10 and 11, thence S 53.18 N. 200 feet  
to an iron pin on Mission Street, thence with  
said Mission Street S. 36-51 E (50) feet to the point.
