We, Nellie A. Bryant and Fred L. Bryant, of Greenville County, State aforesaid SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, We, the said Nellie A. Bryant and Fred L. Bryant in and by our certain promissory note in writing, of even date with these presents, are well and truly indebted to

The Woodside National Bank of Greenville, S. C. in the full and just sum of Eight Thousand (\$8000.00) Dollars, to be paid January 1st, 1929

with interest thereon, from maturity at the rate of 8 per cent. per annum to be computed and paid semi-annually

until paid in full. all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of 10 per cent. besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); and by the said note, reference being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to us, the said Nellie A. Bryant and Fred L. Bryant in hand well and truly

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof we have acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said The Woodside National Bank, its successors and assigns:

All that certain lot or parcel of land situate, lying and being in the City of Greenville, South Carolina, on the west side of Ridgeland Avenue, in Block 10 and being known and designated as Lot No. 21 on a plat made by Dalton Jones, Feb. 1926, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit: -

Beginning at an iron pin in the northern line of Ridgeland Avenue joint corner of Lots Nos. 20 and 21, and running thence with the joint line of said lots N. 11-316.200.6 feet to an iron pin in line of a 15-foot alley, thence with said alley N. 69-187.65 feet to an iron pin, corner of Lot No. 22, thence with the line of that lot S. 13-327.233.8 feet to an iron pin in Ridgeland Avenue, thence with the northern side of said avenue, N. 84-196.75 feet to the point of beginning.
