WITNESSETH, Whereas, the said party of the first part is indebted to said MECHANICS BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION in the sum of

one thousand two hundred dollars, money loaned this day, with interest thereon from this date at the rate of eight

per cent. per annum, payable weekly, the payment whereof the said party of the first part is anxious to secure:

Now, therefore, in consideration of the premises, and in further consideration of one dollar to him in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the said party of the first part has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said party of the second part all that certain piece, parcel and lot of land lying in Greenville County, in the State aforesaid, as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the south side of West Park Avenue, in Ward One, City of Greenville, 42 feet from the south-west corner of Jones and West Park Avenue, (Formerly Carver) and running thence with Park Avenue N. 76-30 W. 5-0 feet to the center of a drive way ten feet wide, referred to in deed of Jessie L. Floyd to B. H. Brannell; thence with center of said drive way S. 13-30, W. 15-0 feet to the center of the branch; thence down center of branch 5-0 feet; thence N. 13-30 E. 146 feet to the point of beginning, and being the same lot conveyed to me by A. J. Drummond, died, dated March 15, 1926 and recorded in the Office of the Register of Deeds, Greenville County, South Carolina in Volume 115, at page 5;
