WHEREAS, I the said Jane G. Huntington, am

in hand well and truly paid by the said PIEDMONT SAVINGS AND TRUST COMPANY, at and before the sealing and delivery of these Presents, (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have granted, bargained, sold and released, and, by these presents, do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said PIEDMONT SAVINGS AND TRUST COMPANY all that tract or parcel of land, situated in County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, and described as follows:

All those two certain lots or parcels of land situate, lying and being in the City of Greenville, South Carolina on the North side of Anglewood Street and being known and designated as lots No. 23 and No. 24 of Cleveland Terrace as shown on plat made by Dalton & Neves, Engineers and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin in the Northern line of Anglewood Street, joint corner of lots 24 and 25 and running thence with the line of lot No. 25 N. 24-176. 225 feet to an iron pin on a fifteen foot alley; thence with the Southern line of said alley S. 69-180. 120 feet to an iron pin in line of lot No. 22; thence with line of that lot S. 18-28 N. 27. 5 feet to an iron pin in the Northern line of Anglewood Street; thence with said Anglewood Street 37 feet along a curved line the tangent of which is N. 69-155 N. to a point; thence still with Anglewood Street N. 42-17 N. 49 feet; thence still with Anglewood Street 70 feet along a curved line the tangent of which is N. 46-13 N. to the point of beginning.
