To All Whom These Presents May  
Concern:

I, C. A. Rector, Sheriff of the County of Greenville  
in the state aforesaid, send greeting.

Whereas, by virtue of an execution issued  
out of the Court of Common Pleas, for the County  
of Greenville, tested the 6th day of July, in the  
year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred  
and twenty-eight and returnable according to  
law, directed to the Sheriff of Greenville County,  
and lodged in his office on the 12th day of  
July, A. D. 1928, commanding him out of the person-  
al and real property of Sara B. Taylor, deceased,  
to satisfy a certain judgment which was render-  
ed on the 20th day of June one thousand nine  
hundred and twenty-eight in an action in  
the said Court between Citizens Bank of Taylors  
Plaintiff vs. Mamie Taylor Connelly, Executrix Sara  
B. Taylor, defendant, in favor of the Citizens Bank  
of Taylors against the said Executrix aforesaid,  
for the sum of five hundred forty-five  
dollars and twenty-eight cents, dollars, and  
interest, as appears by the Judgment Roll,  
filed in the office of the clerk of the Court of  
Common Pleas for said County, I have levied  
upon a certain lot in the County of Greenville,  
hereinafter more particularly described.

the highest and last bidder for the
