

Union Trust Company of Maryland, of Baltimore, Maryland, and South Carolina National Bank of Charleston, Greenville, S.C. Trustees, in the deed of trust hereinafter set forth in consideration of the debt thereby secured, having been fully paid and satisfied and with the consent of the Mortgage Security Corporation of America, of Norfolk, Virginia, the holder of said indebtedness do hereby release the lien of a certain deed of trust made by R. E. All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the ward one of the City of Greenville on the southwest side of Hampton Avenue and having, according to survey made August 1928, by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, the following meters and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the southwest side of Hampton Avenue, which pin is 305 feet northwest of the intersection of Hampton Avenue, and Frank Street, and running thence with the southwest side of said Hampton Avenue N. 32-25-21. 52 feet to an iron pin on the south side of a ten foot alley; thence with the south side of the said Alley S. 57-35-21. 140 feet to an iron pin on the northwest side of an alley; thence with the northwest side of said alley S. 32-25 E. 52 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 57-35 E. 140 feet to an iron pin on Hampton Avenue, the point of beginning.
