For, and in consideration of the sum of One (\$1.00) to it in hand paid at and before the signing, sealing and delivery of these presents, receipts of which is hereby acknowledged and other good and valuable consideration to it moving, The Federal Land Bank of Columbia the owner and holder of a certain mortgage executed to it by C. E. Gary, dated the 22nd day of November, 1927, and recorded in the Office of the Clerk of Court for Greenville County in mortgage Book 120 at page 191 and the note of given date for \$3500.00 secured thereby does hereby release and forever relinquish the lien of said mortgage in so far, and so far only, as the same covers and embraces the following described tract of land:

All that parcel or tract of land containing 25.06 acres more or less, situate, lying and being about one and one-half miles west of the Town of Fountain Inn, in Fair View Township, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, described as follows: Beginning at an iron pin S. L. Coleman and Gladys Pollard's corner, thence running South 72° west, 9.65 Chains to an iron pin in center of a road; thence along the center line of said road, North 11¼° west, 24.50 chains to an iron pin; thence North 17¼° East, 8.86 Chains to an iron pin; thence South 68° East, 2.92 Chains to an iron pin; thence South 7¼° East, 23.00 chains to an iron pin the point of beginning, said tract being bounded on the north by lands of C. S. Armstrong and W. D. Edwards, on the east by lands of W. D. Edwards and S. L. Coleman on the south by lands of Gladys Pollard and on the west by lands of C. E. Gary, all of which will more fully appear by reference to a plat thereof made by C. E. Gary surveyor, copy of which is on file with The Federal Land Bank of Columbia.
