 in and by *my certain Promissory Note* even date with these presents, *our* in the full and just sum of *Fifteen hundred (\$1500.00)* Dollars, to be paid *on or before Three years from date*.

with interest thereon, from *date* computed and paid *Semi-annually* at the rate of *eight* per cent. per annum to be

until paid in full all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal, and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note..... to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for attorney's fees of *one-half of one per cent*

besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note....., to be collected as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note....., reference being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That *the said J. Bessie Rogers* in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said *South Carolina National Bank, Trustee*,

according to the terms of the said note....., and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to *me*, the said *Bessie Rogers*

in hand well and truly paid by the said *South Carolina National Bank, Trustee*, at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said *South Carolina National Bank, Trustee*,

all that certain tract of land in the county and state aforesaid, in Greenville Township, about one-half mile east of the city limits of Greenville, on the Spartanburg Road, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit: Beginning at an iron Pin on the north side of the Spartanburg Road, corner of W. Ross Starr's Property, thence along line of said ~~Property~~ ^{dated} 1920. 45 W. 323 feet to iron Pipe on rear line, thence along rear line 8.81.38 W. 60 feet to an iron Pipe corner H. K. Townes Property, thence along said line 8.210 A.M. E. 336.5 feet to an iron Pipe on the north side of Spartanburg Road; thence along the north side of said road N. 69.02 E. 75 feet to the Point of beginning, being a Part of the John Thompson Tract of land and originally containing 13 acres, more or less, Conveyed to me by H.
