at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said *The First National Bank of Greer, S.C.:*

Those certain lots in Chick Spring Township, said County and State designated as Lots nos. 78 79 106 and 107 on plat of T. N. Brockman's Estate, by Dalton & Nevel, dated June 1926, each of said lots having a frontage of 70 feet and a depth of uniform width of 175 feet, and together bounded North by National Highway; East by lots #80 and #105; South by King Street, and West by Hunt Street. Also, Lots nos. 3 and 4 on said plat, Lot no. 3 having thereon the home of grantor fronting on the National Highway, and measuring on its northern and southern lines 115 feet, and on its eastern and western lines 200 feet and bounded South by National Highway; East by Lot #2; North by Lot #4, and West by Park Ave., and Lot #4 measuring on its southern line 205 feet; on the East or north-east 135 feet; on the north 145 feet and on the West 70 feet; bounded South by Lots 2 & 3; East and north-east by lands of Few; North by Lot #5 and West by Park Ave. On Lots 3 and 4, this mortgage is junior to mortgage given or to be given to Pilot Life Ins.
