all that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, ly-  
ing and being in the State of South Carolina, Coun-  
ty of Greenville, and in the City of Greenville, being  
known as the property of N. F. Burgess Estate, to-wit:  
Beginning at a stake on the Southwest line of  
Bryncombe Street at the Northeast corner of the lot  
of land owned by James N. Carlisle and running  
thence along the line of the Carlisle lot in a South-  
westerly direction 241 ft. more or less, to a stake;  
thence in a Northeastly direction 124.2 ft. to a
