Lindsay to The Union Trust Company of Maryland and the American Bank and Trust Company, as Trustees, dated the 1st day of December, 1925, and recorded in the office of the Register of Mesne Conveyances of Greenville, South Carolina on the 16th day of December, 1925, in Book 167 at page 49, the property thereby conveyed being described as follows:

Certain real estate in the County of Greenville, in the State of South Carolina, particularly described as follows, to-wit:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in Greenville Township, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, near the City of Greenville, in the subdivision known as Overbrook, and designated on a plat of said subdivision as Lot no 64, and having according to a plat prepared by C. M. Furman, Jr., Engineer October 26, 1925 the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at a stake on the East side of Overbrook Circle, joint corner of lots Nos 63 and 64, and running thence with said circle S. 12-38 W. 50.8 feet to a point; thence S. 11-37 E. 50 feet to a point; thence S. 24-20 E. 50 feet to a point; thence S. 42-33 E. 49.9 feet to a point; thence S. 58-03 E. 56.1 feet to a stake, corner of lot no 65; thence along joint line of lots nos 64 and 65, passing the head of an alley abutting lot no. 64, N. 13-13 E.
