at a meeting of the regular conference of the Park Place Baptist Church, the following resolution was presented, and read, to-wit:

"Be It Resolved by the Park Place Baptist Church, in conference assembled, that the board of deacons of this church, be, and they are hereby authorized, empowered, and directed to forthwith execute a note or notes, in a sum not exceeding Fifteen Hundred Dollars, (\$1500.00) in favor of Planters Savings Bank of Greer, S. C., or to any other person, firm or corporation, from whom they can secure this loan, said note or notes to mature at some date in the future, not exceeding twelve months; that in order to better secure payment of said note or notes, said board of deacons are directed, authorized and empowered to execute a real estate mortgage covering certain lot of land in the County and State aforesaid, in Greenville Township, and in Park Place community, and on which a house now started for the purpose of worship is being erected, and being the same lot of land conveyed to the said Church by deed recorded in vol 109 at page 69, R. M. C. Records for Greenville County."

Above motion duly made and seconded and unanimously passed by a rising vote of the congregation. The resolution was adopted. Done and ratified in conference this 17th day of February 1929.
