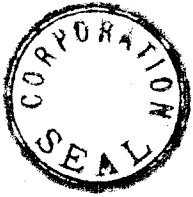

Union Trust Company of Maryland, of Baltimore, Maryland and American Land and Investment Company, (formerly American Bank and Trust Company), of Greenville, South Carolina, Trustee, in the deed of trust hereinafter set forth, in consideration of the debt thereby secured, having been fully paid and satisfied, and with the consent of the Mortgage Security Corporation of America of Norfolk, Virginia, the holder of said indebtedness, do hereby release the lien of a certain deed of trust made by Cullen A. Tripp to the Union Trust Company of Maryland and American Bank and Trust Company, as Trustee, dated on the 15th day of December, 1925, and recorded in the office of the Register of Mesne Conveyance, of Greenville County, South Carolina, in Book 167, page 61; the property thereby conveyed being described as follows:

All that certain lot or parcel of land situate, lying and being in the City of Greenville, South Carolina, at the North-west corner of Randall and Wilton Streets, and having, according to a survey made by Dalton + Neves, Engineers, December 1925, the following meter and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin, the Northwest corner of Randall and Wilton Streets, and running thence with the Northern side of Randall Street, N. 98-15 W., 108 feet, 9 inches to stake; thence N. 2-00 E., 69 feet, 6 inches to an iron pin; thence S. 87-40 E., 108 feet 9 1/2 inches to an iron pin on Wilton Street; thence with said Street, S. 2-00 W., 65 feet to the point of beginning.
