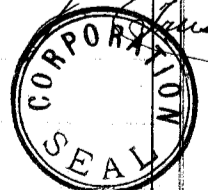

Beginning at an iron Pin on the West side of Lawton Avenue 192 feet South of Douthit Street, and running thence with said Avenue, S. 17-30 W. 54.5 feet to an iron Pin; thence N. 71-30 W. 173 feet to an iron Pin; thence N. 17-30 E. 54.5 feet to an iron Pin; thence S. 71-30 E. 173 feet to an iron Pin on Lawton Avenue, the point of beginning.

The Register of Deeds for Greenville County is hereby authorized and directed to satisfy record of Trust of record by endorsing such satisfaction upon the record of said Deed of Trust in Book no. 167 at Page 177 of Mortgages in the Office of the Register of Deeds for Greenville County, South Carolina.
