the payment whereof the said party of the first part is anxious to secure:

Now, therefore, in consideration of the premises, and in further consideration of one dollar to him in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the said party of the first part has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said party of the second part all that certain piece, parcel and lot of land lying in Greenville County, in the State of S. C., as follows, to wit:

In Trust for the City of Greenville having the following metes and bounds to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the west side of Milton Street, 75 feet southward from the fourth corner of Milton and Craft Streets, and running thence N. 83-13 W. 108 3/4 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 1-40 W. 75 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 83-13 E. 108 3/4 feet to an iron pin on Milton Street; thence with Milton Street N. 1-41 E. 75 feet to the beginning corner; this being the central part of Lot no 36 of Section "C" of the property of Stone Land Company, according to a plat thereof recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "A" at page 341, and being the same lot of land conveyed to me by Mary R. Fuller by deed dated March 2, 1929, and recorded in Volume 148, page 248, R.
