WITNESSETH, Whereas, the said party of the first part is indebted to said MECHANICS BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION in the sum of

Three Hundred

.....Dollars, money loaned this day, with interest thereon from this date at the rate of eight

.....per cent. per annum, payable weekly,

the payment whereof the said party of the first part is anxious to secure:

Now, therefore, in consideration of the premises, and in further consideration of one dollar to him in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the said party of the first part has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said party of the second part all that certain piece, parcel and lot of land lying in Greenville County, in the State aforesaid, as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the West side of
Wilton Street, 75 feet Southward from the Southwest corner
of Wilton and ~~Wilton~~ Streets, and running thence N.
83-13 W. 108 3/4 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 1-41 W. 75 feet
to an iron pin; thence S. 93-136. 108 3/4 feet to an iron
pin on Wilton Street, thence with Wilton Street
N. 1-41 E. 6 feet to the beginning corner. This being
the entire part of Lot No. 36 of Section "6" of the
property of ~~David~~ Land Company according to a
plat thereof recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Green-
ville County, ~~the~~ Plat Book "A", at Page 341, being
the same which was conveyed to me by Mary
K. Fuller by deed dated March 2, 1924, and recorded
in Volume 144, page 248, R. M. C. Office for Greenville
County.
