by and between A. Eugene Brown

WITNESSETH, Whereas, the said party of the first part is indebted to said MECHANICS BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION in the sum of
Fifteen Hundred (1500) Dollars, money loaned the said party of the first part with interest thereon from this date at the rate of eight
per cent. per annum, payable weekly,
the payment whereof the said party of the first part is anxious to secure.

Now, therefore, in consideration of the premises, and in further consideration of one dollar to him in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the
said party of the first part has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said party of the second part all
that certain piece, parcel and lot of land lying in Greenville County, in the State aforesaid, as follows, to-wit:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land
in Greenville Township, Greenville County and
State of South Carolina, in Ward One of the
City of Greenville, on the S. side of St. Stone Ave.,
and having the following metes and bounds,
to-wit:

Beginning at Mary B. Foster's corner and
running thence with Stone Avenue 75 feet to a
stake; thence S. 52. 257 feet, more or less
to a stake; thence N. 85. 55 21. 75 ft to a stake
Foster's S. E. corner; thence with Foster's line
261 ft, more or less, to the beginning corner,
and is more fully shown by plat of record
in Plat Book A, page 341; being the same
lot of land conveyed to me by Wayne P. Glover
recorded in Vol 45, page 566, in R. M. C. Office
for Greenville County, Aug 9, 1919.
