party of the first part, and the Mechanics Building and Loan Association, of Greenville, S. C., a corporation, party of the second part,

WITNESSETH, Whereas the said party of the first part is indebted to said MECHANICS BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION in the sum of Five hundred and no/100 Dollars, money loaned this 1st day of September 1929 at the rate of eight per cent. per annum, payable weekly,

the payment whereof the said party of the first part is desirous to secure:
Now, therefore, in consideration of the premises, and in further consideration of one dollar to him in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the said party of the first part has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said party of the second part all that certain piece, parcel and lot of land lying in Greenville County, in the State aforesaid, as follows, to-wit:

Being a portion of Lot No. 60 as shown on plat of Carl subdivision near Casley Bridge Road, property of Loper & Yawn, recorded Plat Book F, page 77 and containing the following courses and distances:

Beginning at an iron pin on the Northwest corner of Jordan Street and White Horse Road and running thence with White Horse Road N. 11° E. 56 feet to stake, thence S. 79-45 W. 152 feet more or less to stake in line of lot hereinafter described, thence with line of said lot S. 10-15° E. 53 feet to stake on Jordan Street, thence with Jordan Street N. 79-45° E. 135 feet to the beginning.

Also: all that other lot in Township and county and State aforesaid, adjoining the lot above described, being a portion of said lot No. 60 on plat of Loper & Yawn property described as follows:

Beginning at a stake on North side of Jordan Street 135 feet West of the White Horse Road and running thence with Jordan Street S. 79-45 W. 55 feet to an iron pin, corner of lot No. 58; thence with line of said lot N. 10-15 W. 150 feet to stake, corner of Mary Chandler lot; thence with Mary Chandler lot N. 79-45 E. 55 feet; thence S. 10-15 E. 150 feet to the beginning, being the same conveyed to Greenville Trading Company by John A. Russell by his deed dated October 18, 1928, and recorded on the same day in Vol. 146, page 345, R. M. C. office for Greenville County.
