 Whereas, the said Lola F. Cox and Calvin E. Cox, her husband, being on January 14th, 1929, indebted unto The Prudential Insurance Company of America, in the full and just principal sum of One Thousand Dollars, which sum they evidenced by their note or obligation in the amount of One Thousand Dollars, dated January 14, 1929, said note being due and payable on January 14, 1934, and bearing interest at the rate of five and one half per centum per annum; and

Whereas, the said Lola F. Cox and Calvin E. Cox, her husband, in order to secure the payment of said principal sum of One Thousand Dollars and the interest to accrue thereon, did by their certain mortgage, dated January 14, 1929, and duly recorded in Book 172, page 76, of the records of Greenville County, State of South Carolina, grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said The Prudential Insurance Company of America, forty and forty two one hundredths (40.42) acres of land situated in Austin Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, and in said mortgage described by courses and distances; and

Whereas in said mortgage in describing the real estate intended to be conveyed there by a clerical error was made in fourth course, which is the southerly boundary line, making said fourth course read "thence continuing along line of Fowler S. 86° 30' E. 77.2 feet to an iron pin" where it should have read "thence continuing along line of Fowler S. 86° 30' E. 772 feet to an iron pin" as shown on survey made by W. J. Riddle, Surveyor, under date of March 17, 1926, referred to in said description, and as was the intention of all the parties to said mortgage; and
