

apply for a receiver to take charge of the mortgaged premises, who may be authorized to collect the rents and profits and outstanding contracts of sale, and to do any other acts that may be deemed advisable. All expenses of such receivership shall be a first lien upon the assets coming into its hands, including the mortgaged premises. In case of suit or foreclosure, the Court, on motion of the Trustee, may declare all notes secured hereby due and payable, and require them to be established in said case by publishing such notice as to the Court may seem just.

And It Is Agreed that the Trustee shall not be liable for any error of judgment in the discharge of its duties.

And The South Carolina National Bank of Charleston, S. C., does hereby agree to act as Trustee, under the terms of the foregoing mortgage.
