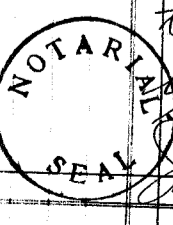

B. Bayliss dated April 1, 1929 and recorded in R.M.C. Greenville County South Carolina, in Mortgage Book no. 196, at page 21, and not to L. O. Lohman as erroneously stated on the face of said notes.
