TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN:

of Greenville, in the County of Greenville, and the State of South Carolina, send Greeting:

WHEREAS, W.D. Parrish, the said, in and by my certain note or obligation, bearing date the 28th day of October 1928

indebted unto The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, of the City and County of Greenville, in said State (a body corporate, duly incorporated under the laws of such State) the sum of Seven hundred \$700.00 Dollars, with interest thereon at the rate of eight per centum per annum, payable monthly, from the 28th day of October A. D. 1928

according to the provisions of the Charter, By-Laws, Rules and Regulations of the said Company, in manner and form following, that is to say, that the said shall pay or cause to be paid to the said Company, or its certain attorneys, successors or assigns, at Greenville City aforesaid, monthly, on the 20th or before the end of the month of November 1928, and on the 20th or before the end of each month thereafter for twenty successive months, the sum of Eleven + 08/100 (\$11.08)

Dollars, (\$7.00) Dollars, being the regular monthly installment payable on the Seven Shares of Stock, and Four + 08/100 (\$4.08) Dollars, being the monthly interest on the advance or loan) until there have been paid twenty monthly payments, and shall for the next twenty months pay the sum of Dollars, (\$7.00)

Dollars, being the regular monthly payment on said stock and Three + 45/100 (\$3.27) Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due); for the next twenty months the sum of Nine + 45/100 (\$9.45) Dollars, (\$7.00) Dollars, being the regular monthly payment on said stock and Two + 45/100 (\$2.45)

Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due); for the next twenty months pay the sum of Eight + 03/100 (\$8.63) Dollars, (\$7.00) Dollars, being the monthly payment on said shares of stock and Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due); for the next twenty months pay

the sum of Seven + 82/100 (\$7.82) Dollars, (\$7.00) Dollars, being the monthly payment on said shares of stock and 82/100 (\$82) Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due.)

Each of the above payments to be made on the 20th or before the last day of each month, and shall thereafter surrender to the Company the said seven shares of stock and the certificate therefor, the amount at such time paid shall be credited as a payment upon the advance or loan made, the said and shall pay or cause to be paid all fines which may be duly imposed upon or charged against me the said W.D. Parrish

in accordance with the Charter, By-Laws, Rules and Regulations, as in and by the said note or obligation, and the condition thereunder written, reference being thereunto had will more fully appear. NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I W.D. Parrish in consideration of the said debt and sum of money as aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, according to the terms of said note or obligation, and also in consideration of the further sum of Five Dollars to me the said W.D. Parrish

in hand well and truly paid by the said The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, at and before the sealing and delivery of these Presents, (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents, do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, all that tract or parcel of land, situated in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, and described as follows:

lying in the City of Greenville and being a portion of lots nos. 19 and 20 as shown on a plat of the Carson property made by J. P. Laurens, dated Jan. 1902, and recorded in Plat Book G, page 61, P. M. C. Office for said Greenville County. The said lot having the following metes and bounds:

Beginning at an iron pin on a twenty-foot alley; way one hundred (100) feet from the south side of Grove Street at the corner of the Erod property, and thence running along the line of that property in a westerly direction one hundred (100) feet to an iron pin; thence in a southerly direction fifty (50) feet to an iron pin at the corner of the Belotte property, the said corner being a distance of fifty (50) feet north of a thirty-foot street and thence running along the line of the Belotte property one hundred (100) feet to an iron pin on a twenty-foot alley; thence along the said alley in a north-westerly direction fifty (50) feet to the beginning corner and being the same lot conveyed to W.D. Parrish by J. F. Wilborn by deed dated October 8, 1928, to be recorded.
