

THE STATE OF SOUTH CAROLINA,

TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN:

We, J. W. Whitmire and Mattie S. Whitmire of Greenville, in the County of Greenville, and the State of South Carolina, send Greeting:

WHEREAS, We, the said J. W. Whitmire and Mattie S. Whitmire in and by my certain note or obligation, bearing date the 4th day of December 1928

indebted unto The Carolina Loan and Trust Company of the City and County of Greenville, in said State (a body corporate, duly incorporated under the laws of such State), in the sum of Five Hundred (\$500.00) Dollars,

with interest thereon at the rate of eight per centum per annum, payable monthly, from the 4th day of December, A. D. 1928, according to the provisions of the Charter, By-Laws, Rules and Regulations of the said Company, in manner and form following, that is to say, that

the said J. W. Whitmire and Mattie S. Whitmire shall pay or cause to be paid to the said Company, or its certain attorneys, successors or assigns, at Greenville City aforesaid, monthly, on the 20th or before the end of the month of January 1929, and on the 20th or before the end of each month thereafter for twenty successive months, the sum of

Seven and 92/100 (\$7.92) Dollars, (Five Dollars, being the regular monthly installment payable on the Five Shares of Stock and Two + 92/100 (\$2.92) Dollars, being the monthly interest on the advance or loan) until there have been paid twenty monthly payments, and shall for the next twenty months pay the sum of

Seven + 33/100 (\$7.33) Dollars, (\$5.00 Dollars, being the regular monthly payment on said stock and Two + 33/100 (\$2.33) Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due); for the next twenty months the sum of

Five + 75/100 (\$5.75) Dollars, (\$5.00 Dollars, being the regular monthly payment on said stock and One + 75/100 (\$1.75) Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due); for the next twenty months pay the sum of

Five + 58/100 (\$5.58) Dollars, (\$5.00 Dollars, being the regular monthly payment on said shares of stock and Five + 58/100 (\$5.58) Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due.)

Each of the above payments to be made on the 20th or before the last day of each month, and shall thereafter surrender to the Company the said Five shares of stock and the certificate thereof, the amount at such time paid shares by us to be credited as a payment upon the advance or loan made us, the said J. W. Whitmire and Mattie S. Whitmire

and shall pay or cause to be paid all fines which may be duly imposed upon, or charged against us, the said J. W. Whitmire and Mattie S. Whitmire in accordance with the Charter, By-Laws, Rules and Regulations, as in and by the said note or obligation, and the condition thereunder written, reference being thereunto had will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That We, the said J. W. Whitmire and Mattie S. Whitmire in consideration of the said debt and sum of money as aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, according to the terms of said note or obligation, and also in consideration of the further sum of Five Dollars to

the said J. W. Whitmire and Mattie S. Whitmire in hand well and truly paid by the said The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, at and before the sealing and delivery of these Presents, (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents, do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, all that tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, and described as follows:

Lying on the branch of Bushy Creek, water off Peedy River and beginning according to plat made by M. J. ... Jr., Civil Engineer, November 2, 1928, the following metes and bounds to-wit:

Beginning at a certain corner on Lemuel Bayliss' corner, and running thence N. 20 E. 12.70 chains to a stake, thence S. 70 E. 12.75 chains to a stake on the corner of property this day conveyed to J. M. ...; thence along the line of that property N 68-30 21 14.90 chains to a stake, thence N. 87 E. 7.75 chains to the beginning corner, and being the same tract of land conveyed to J. W. Whitmire and Mattie S. Whitmire by Fannie S. Whitmire November 4, 1906, by deed recorded in Deed Book 3, 2, 4, at page 48, in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, and containing 20 acres, more or less.

For value received The Carolina Loan & Trust Co. hereby assigns, transfers & sets over unto W. R. Hale, the within mortgage and the note it secures without recourse on, etc. Dec 15, 1937.
