

THE STATE OF SOUTH CAROLINA,

TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN:

I, Lee Gillians of Greenville, in the County of Greenville, and the State of South Carolina send Greeting:

WHEREAS, Lee Gillians, the said Lee Gillians in and by my certain note or obligation, bearing date the 10th day of January 1929

indebted unto The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, of the City and County of Greenville, in said State (a body corporate, duly incorporated under the laws of such State), in the sum of Two Hundred Fifty (\$250.00) Dollars,

with interest thereon at the rate of eight per centum per annum, payable monthly, from the 10th day of January A. D. 1929 according to the provisions of the Charter, By-Laws, Rules and Regulations of the said Company, in manner and form following, that is to say, that

I the said Lee Gillians shall pay or cause to be paid to the said Company, or its certain attorneys, successors or assigns, at Greenville City aforesaid, monthly, on the 20th or before the end of the month of February 1929, and on the 20th or before the end of each month thereafter for twenty successive months, the sum of

Three & 98/100 (\$3.98) Dollars, (\$2.50) Dollars, being the regular monthly installment payable on the two & one-half Shares of Stock and One & 49/100 (\$1.48)

Dollars, being the monthly interest, on the advance or loan) until there have been paid twenty monthly payments, and shall for the next twenty months pay the sum of

Three & 67/100 (\$3.67) Dollars, (2.50) Dollars, being the regular monthly payment on said stock and One & 17/100 (\$1.17) Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due);

for the next twenty months the sum of Three & 81/100 (\$3.81) Dollars, (\$2.50) Dollars, being the regular monthly payment on said stock and 89/100 (\$0.88)

Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due); for the next twenty months pay the sum of Three and 40/100 (\$3.08) Dollars, (\$2.50) Dollars, being the monthly payment on said shares of stock and 58/100 (\$0.58)

the sum of One & 40/100 (\$1.40) Dollars, (\$2.50) Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due); for the next twenty months pay the sum of One & 40/100 (\$1.40) Dollars, (\$2.50) Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due.)

Each of the above payments to be made on the 20th or before the last day of each month, and shall thereafter surrender to the Company the said 2 1/2 shares of stock and the certificate thereof, the amount at such time paid shares by me to be credited as a payment upon the advance or loan made me the said Lee Gillians

and shall pay or cause to be paid all fines which may be duly imposed upon, or charged against me the said Lee Gillians in accordance with the Charter, By-Laws, Rules and Regulations, as in and by the said note or obligation, and the condition thereunder written, reference being thereunto had will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That Lee Gillians in consideration of the said debt and sum of money as aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, according to the terms of said note or obligation, and also in consideration of the further sum of Five Dollars

the said Lee Gillians in hand well and truly paid by the said The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, at and before the sealing and delivery of these Presents, (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents, do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, all that tract or parcel of land, situated in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, and described as follows:

In the City of Greenville, South Carolina, beginning at a stake on Brier Street and thence running with Brier Street north 48 feet to a stake; thence with Brier Street east 112 feet, more or less to a stake on W.C. Cleveland's line; thence south 40 feet to a stake on J. H. Seawright's old corner; thence with J. H. Seawright's old line 102 feet to the beginning corner, and being the same lot conveyed to Lee Gillians by James A. Brier, September 17, 1925 by deed recorded in Volume 163, at page 23, in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County.
