of Greenville, in the County of Greenville, and the State of South Carolina, send Greeting:

WHEREAS, J. P. Chappell, the said J. P. Chappell, in and by my certain note or obligation, bearing date the 27th day of March 1929

indebted unto The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, of the City and County of Greenville, in said State (a body corporate, duly incorporated under the laws of such State), in the sum of Two Thousand (\$2,000.00) Dollars, with interest thereon at the rate of eight per centum per annum, payable monthly, from the 27th day of March A. D. 1929 according to the provisions of the Charter, By-Laws, Rules and Regulations of the said Company, in manner and form following, that is to say, that

the said J. P. Chappell shall pay or cause to be paid to the said Company, or its certain attorneys, successors or assigns, at Greenville City aforesaid, monthly, on the 20th or before the end of the month of April 1929, and on the 20th or before the end of each month thereafter for twenty successive months, the sum of Sixty-one & 67/100 (\$61.67) Dollars, (\$20.00

Dollars, being the regular monthly installment payable on the twenty Shares of Stock, and Seven & 67/100 (\$7.67) Dollars, being the monthly interest on the advance or loan) until there have been paid twenty monthly payments, and shall for the next twenty months pay the sum of Twenty-nine & 33/100 (\$29.33) Dollars, (\$20.00

Dollars, being the regular monthly payment on said stock and Twenty & 33/100 (\$20.33) Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due); for the next twenty months the sum of Twenty-seven (\$27.00) Dollars, (\$20.00

Dollars, being the regular monthly payment on said stock and Seven (\$7.00) Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due) for the next twenty months pay the sum of Twenty-four & 67/100 (\$24.67) Dollars, (\$20.00

Dollars, being the monthly payment on said shares of stock and Four & 67/100 (\$4.67) Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due); for the next twenty months pay the sum of Twenty-two & 33/100 (\$22.33) Dollars, (\$20.00

Dollars, being the monthly payment on said shares of stock and Two & 33/100 (\$2.33) Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due.) Each of the above payments to be made on the 20th or before the last day of each month, and shall thereafter surrender to the Company the said twenty shares of stock and the certificate thereof, the amount at such time paid shares by me to be credited as a payment upon the advance or loan made, the said

and shall pay or cause to be paid all taxes which may be duly imposed upon, or charged against me, the said J. P. Chappell, in accordance with the Charter, By-Laws, Rules and Regulations, as in and by the said note or obligation, and the condition thereunder written, reference being thereunto had will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I, the said J. P. Chappell, in consideration of the said debt and sum of money as aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said Carolina Loan and Trust Company, according to the terms of said note or obligation, and also in consideration of the further sum of Five Dollars to me, the said

J. P. Chappell, in hand well and truly paid by the said The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, at and before the sealing and delivery of these Presents, (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents, do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, all that tract or parcel of land, situated in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, and described as follows:

lying in the City of Greenville, containing seven tenths of an acre, more or less, and having the following metes and bounds: Beginning at a stake at or near Greenville and Columbia Railroad about one mile west of Greenville Court House, and running thence S. 9 1/2 W. 5.75 chains; thence N. 89 W. 1.42 chains to a stake; thence N. 9 1/2 E. 5.09 chains to a stake; thence S. 67 E. 1.58 chains to beginning corner and being the same land conveyed to said J. P. Chappell by J. C. Milford, August 24, 1911, by deed recorded in Volume 13 at page 346, R. M. C. Office for Greenville County.
