

THE STATE OF SOUTH CAROLINA,

TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN:

J. E. Medlin of Greenville, in the County of Greenville, and the State of South Carolina, send Greeting:

WHEREAS, *J. E. Medlin*, the said *J. E. Medlin* in and by *my* certain note or obligation, bearing date the *15th* day of *July* 192*9*

J. E. Medlin indebted unto The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, of the City and County of Greenville, in said State (a body corporate, duly incorporated under the laws of such State), in the sum of, *Seven hundred fifty (\$750.00)* Dollars,

with interest thereon at the rate of eight per centum per annum, payable monthly, from the *15th* day of *July* A. D. 192*9* according to the provisions of the Charter, By-Laws, Rules and Regulations of the said *J. E. Medlin* Company, in manner and form following, that is to say, that *J. E. Medlin* the said *J. E. Medlin* shall pay or cause to be paid to the said

Company, or its certain attorneys, successors or assigns, at Greenville City aforesaid, monthly, on the 20th or before the end of the month of *August* 192*9*, and on the 20th or before the end of each month thereafter for twenty successive months, the sum of *Eleven & 8/100 (\$11.88)* Dollars, (*\$7.50*) Dollars,

being the regular monthly installment payable on the *Eleven & one half* Shares of Stock, and *Four & 38/100 (\$4.38)* Dollars, being the monthly interest (on the advance or loan) until there have been paid twenty monthly payments, and shall for the next twenty months pay the sum of *Eleven & 11/100 (\$11.10)* Dollars, (*\$7.50*) Dollars,

being the regular monthly payment on said stock and *Three & 50/100 (\$3.50)* Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due); for the next twenty months the sum of *Seven & 13/100 (\$7.13)* Dollars, (*\$7.50*) Dollars, being the regular monthly payment on said stock and *Two & 63/100 (\$2.63)* Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due); for the next twenty months pay the sum of *Nine & 25/100 (\$9.25)* Dollars, (*\$7.50*) Dollars, being the monthly payment on said shares of stock and *One & 25/100 (\$1.25)* Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due); for the next twenty months pay the sum of *Eight & 35/100 (\$8.35)* Dollars, (*\$7.50*) Dollars, being the monthly payment on said shares of stock and *Two & 88/100 (\$2.88)* Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due.)

Each of the above payments to be made on the 20th or before the last day of each month, and shall thereafter surrender to the Company the said *7 1/2* shares of stock and the certificate thereof, the amount at such time paid shares by *me* to be credited as a payment upon the advance or loan made *me*, the said *J. E. Medlin* and shall pay or cause to be paid all taxes which may be duly imposed upon, or charged against *me* the said *J. E. Medlin* in accordance with the Charter, By-Laws, Rules and Regulations, as in and by the said note or obligation, and the condition thereunder written, reference being thereunto had will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That *J. E. Medlin* the said *J. E. Medlin* in consideration of the said debt and sum of money as aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, according to the terms of said note or obligation, and also in consideration of the further sum of Five Dollars to the said *J. E. Medlin* in hand well and truly paid by the said The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, at and before the signing and delivery of these Presents, (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents, do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, all that tract or parcel of land, situated in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, and described as follows:

With all the improvements thereon situate, lying and being in Greenville County, South Carolina, about two and one half miles west of Greenville Court House known and designated as lot no. 8 of Block 2 on a plat of a subdivision known as "Hoke Subdivision", which plat is recorded in Plat Book "C", page 54, said lot having a frontage of 50 feet, more or less, on Gentry Street, and running back therefrom in parallel lines a depth of 150 feet more or less, and adjoining lot no. 10, this is the same land conveyed to J. E. Medlin by Dealamy Eassey by deed dated April 8, 1929, recorded in the R.M. Office for Greenville County in volume 127, page 362.
