

THE STATE OF SOUTH CAROLINA,

TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN:

I, Frank S. White, Jr. of Greenville, in the County of Greenville, and the State of South Carolina, send Greeting:

WHEREAS, I, Frank S. White, Jr. in and by my certain note or obligation, bearing date the 3rd day of December 1929

indebted unto The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, of the City and County of Greenville, in said State (a body corporate, duly incorporated under the laws of such State), in the sum of Seven Hundred Fifty (\$750.00) Dollars, with interest thereon at the rate of eight per centum per annum, payable monthly, from the 3rd day of December A. D. 1929, according to the provisions of the Charter, By-Laws, Rules and Regulations of the said Company, in manner and form following, that is to say, that I the said Frank S. White, Jr. shall pay or cause to be paid to the said Company, or its certain attorneys, successors or assigns, at Greenville City aforesaid, monthly, on the 20th or before the end of the month of January 1929, and on the 20th or before the end of each month thereafter for twenty successive months, the sum of Eleven + 88/100 (\$11.88) Dollars, (\$7.50) Dollars, being the regular monthly installment payable on the seven and one-half Shares of Stock, and Four + 38/100 (\$4.38) Dollars, being the monthly interest on the advance or loan) until there have been paid twenty monthly payments, and shall for the next twenty months pay the sum of Eleven (\$11.00) Dollars, (\$7.50) Dollars, being the regular monthly payment on said stock and Three + 50/100 (\$3.50) Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due); for the next twenty months pay the sum of Seven + 13/100 (\$7.13) Dollars, being the regular monthly payment on said stock and Two + 63/100 (\$2.63) Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due); for the next twenty months pay the sum of Nine + 25/100 (\$9.25) Dollars, being the regular monthly payment on said shares of stock and One + 75/100 (\$1.75) Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due); for the next twenty months pay the sum of Eight + 38/100 (\$8.38) Dollars, (\$7.50) Dollars, being the regular monthly payment on said shares of stock and 88/100 (\$1.88) Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due.)

Each of the above payments to be made on the 20th or before the last day of each month, and shall thereafter surrender to the Company the said 7 1/2 shares of stock and the certificate thereof, the amount at such time paid shares by me to be credited as a payment upon the advance or loan made to the said

and shall pay or cause to be paid all fines which may be duly imposed upon, or charged against me the said Frank S. White, Jr. in accordance with the Charter, By-Laws, Rules and Regulations, as in and by the said note or obligation, and the condition thereunder written, reference being thereunto had will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I, Frank S. White, Jr. in consideration of the said debt and sum of money as aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, according to the terms of said note or obligation, and also in consideration of the further sum of Five Dollars to me the said Frank S. White, Jr.

in hand well and truly paid by the said The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, at and before the sealing and delivery of these Presents, (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents, do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, all that tract or parcel of land, situated in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, and described as follows:

on Manly Street, in the City of Greenville, and known as Lot No. 3 of the parcel conveyed to C. H. Croaskeys by Mary S. Craft, as described in the deed recorded in Deed Book A. S. S., Page 401, R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at a stake on Manly Street about 95 feet from corner of Manly Street and Ann Street, and running thence N. 12 1/2 - 30 W. 50 feet with Manly Street to a stake; thence S. 77-50 W. 146 feet to a stake; thence S. 12-30 E. 50 feet to a stake; thence N. 77-30 E. 146 feet to the beginning corner, and being the same lot of land conveyed to me, said Frank S. White, Jr., by Wm. Goldenstich by deed dated October 23, 1919, and recorded in Deed Book 56, page 150, R. M. C. Office for said Greenville County.

The above dimensions are according to deed to White, but the city map apparently shows the depth of this lot to be less than as given in the deed.
