

THE STATE OF SOUTH CAROLINA,

TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN:

I, James S. Young of Greenville, in the County of Greenville, and the State of South Carolina, send Greeting:

WHEREAS, I, the said James S. Young in and by my certain note or obligation, bearing date the 23rd day of February 1929 indebted unto The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, of the City and County of Greenville, in said State (a body corporate, duly incorporated under the laws of such State), in the sum of Five Hundred Fifty (\$550.00) Dollars, with interest thereon at the rate of eight per centum per annum, payable monthly from the 23rd day of February A. D. 1929 according to the provisions of the Charter, By-Laws, Rules and Regulations of the said Company, in manner and form following, that is to say, that

I the said James S. Young shall pay or cause to be paid to the said Company, or its certain attorneys, successors or assigns, at Greenville City aforesaid, monthly, on the 20th or before the end of the month of March 1929, and on the 20th or before the end of each month thereafter for twenty successive months, the sum of Eight & 71/100 (\$8.71) Dollars, (\$5.50) Dollars,

being the regular monthly installment payable on the five and one half Shares of Stock and Three & 21/100 (\$3.21) Dollars, being the monthly interest on the advance or loan) until there have been paid twenty monthly payments, and shall for the next twenty months pay the sum of Eight & 57/100 (\$8.57) Dollars, (\$5.50) Dollars,

being the regular monthly payment on said stock and Two & 57/100 (\$2.57) Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due); for the next twenty months the sum of Seven & 42/100 (\$7.42) Dollars, (\$5.50) Dollars, being the regular monthly payment on said stock and One & 92/100 (\$1.92) Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due); for the next twenty months pay the sum of Six & 78/100 (\$6.78) Dollars,

being the monthly installment on said shares of stock and One & 28/100 (\$1.28) Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due); for the next twenty months pay the sum of Six & 14/100 (\$6.14) Dollars, being the monthly installment on said shares of stock and One & 28/100 (\$1.28) Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due.)

Each of the above payments to be made on the 20th or before the last day of each month, and shall thereafter surrender to the Company the said 5 1/2 shares of stock and the certificate thereof, the amount in each time pay shares to be credited as a payment upon the advance or loan made me the said

and shall pay or cause to be paid all fines which may be duly imposed upon, or charged against me the said James S. Young in accordance with the Charter, By-Laws, Rules and Regulations, as in and by the said note or obligation, and the condition thereon or written reference hereunto will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, that I, the said James S. Young in consideration of the said debt and sum of money as aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, according to the terms of said Note or obligation, and also in consideration of the further sum of Five Dollars to the said James S. Young in hand well and truly paid me the said The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, at and before the sealing and delivery of these Presents, (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents, do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, all that tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, and described as follows:

in the City of Greenville, on Southit Street, approximately 200 feet east of Leach Street, with the following metes and bounds;

Beginning at a point something over 200 feet east of Leach St. on the north side of Southit Street and running N. 17 3/4 E. 222 feet to a stone; thence S. 71 1/4 E. 50 feet; thence S. 17 3/4 W. 222 feet to a stone on said Southit Street; thence N. 71 1/4 W. 50 feet to the beginning corner, and being known as Lot No. 11 out plat of property of M. A. Callanan, and being the same conveyed to James S. Young by deed recorded in S. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 49, page 1354.
