

THE STATE OF SOUTH CAROLINA,

TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN:

I Mrs. E. F. Useary of Greenville, in the County of Greenville, and the State of South Carolina, send Greeting:

WHEREAS, I Mrs. E. F. Useary in and by my certain note or obligation, bearing date the 11th day of March 1929

indebted unto The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, of the City and County of Greenville, in said State (a body corporate, duly incorporated under the laws of such State), in the sum of Seven hundred (\$700.00) Dollars,

with interest thereon at the rate of eight per centum per annum, payable monthly from the 14th day of March A. D. 1929 according to the provisions of the Charter, By-Laws, Rules and Regulations of the said Company, in manner and form following, that is to say, that

the said Mrs. E. F. Useary shall pay or cause to be paid to the said Company, or its certain attorneys, successors or assigns, at Greenville City aforesaid, monthly, on the 20th or before the end of the month of April 1929

and on the 20th or before the end of each month thereafter for twenty successive months, the sum of Seven & 25/100 (\$7.25) Dollars,

being the regular monthly installment payable on the seven Shares of Stock and Four & 25/100 (\$4.25) Dollars, being the monthly interest on the advance or loan) until there have been paid twenty monthly payments, and shall for the next twenty months pay the sum of Ten & 25/100 (\$10.25) Dollars,

Dollars, being the regular monthly payment on said stock and Four & 25/100 (\$4.25) Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due); for the next twenty months the sum of Nine & 25/100 (\$9.25) Dollars,

(Dollars, being the regular monthly payment on said stock and Four & 25/100 (\$4.25) Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due); for the next twenty months pay the sum of Eight & 25/100 (\$8.25) Dollars,

(Dollars, being the regular monthly payment on said stock and Four & 25/100 (\$4.25) Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due); for the next twenty months pay the sum of One & 25/100 (\$1.25) Dollars,

(Dollars, being the regular monthly payment on said stock and Four & 25/100 (\$4.25) Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due); for the next twenty months pay the sum of Seven & 25/100 (\$7.25) Dollars,

(Dollars, being the regular monthly payment on said stock and Four & 25/100 (\$4.25) Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due.)

Each of the above payments to be made on the 20th or before the last day of each month, and shall thereafter, surrender to the Company the said seven shares of stock and the certificate thereof, the amount at such time paid shall be credited as a payment upon the advance or loan made, the said Mrs. E. F. Useary

and shall pay or cause to be paid all fines which may be duly imposed upon, or charged against, the said Mrs. E. F. Useary

in accordance with the Charter, By-Laws, Rules and Regulations, as in and by the said note or obligation, and the condition thereunder written, reference being thereunto had will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the said Mrs. E. F. Useary in consideration of the said sum of money as aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said The Carolina Loan and Trust Company,

according to the terms of said note or obligation, and also in consideration of the further sum of Five Dollars to the said Mrs. E. F. Useary

in hand well and truly paid by the said The Carolina Loan and Trust Company at and before the sealing and delivery of these Presents, (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents, do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, all that tract or parcel of land, situated in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, and described as follows:

lying in Greenville Township north of the City of Greenville, being lot 19 of Block B, of Park Place, a subdivision of land represented by a plat recorded in Plat Book "A" page 119, R.M.C. Office for said Greenville County. Said lot has a frontage of fifty feet on First Avenue, and runs back on parallel lines one hundred fifty feet, and is the same which was conveyed to me, the said Mrs. E. F. Useary by Mrs. M. H. (my former name was Elizabeth F. Robinson) deed dated September 23, 1914, said recorded in Deed Book 27 at Page 411, in said R.M.C. office.
