

THE STATE OF SOUTH CAROLINA,

TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN:

I, Carl Fisher
of Greenville, in the County of Greenville, and the State of South Carolina, send Greeting:

WHEREAS, I, the said Carl Fisher
in and by my certain note or obligation, bearing date the 12th day of April 1929
indebted unto The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, of the City and County of Greenville, in said State (a body corporate, duly
incorporated under the laws of such State), in the sum of Eight hundred (\$800.00) Dollars,
with interest thereon at the rate of eight per centum per annum, payable monthly from the 13th day of April A. D. 1929
according to the provisions of the Charter, By-Laws, Rules and Regulations of the said Company, in manner and form following, that is to say, that I
the said Carl Fisher shall pay or cause to be paid to the said

Company, or its certain attorneys, successors or assigns, at Greenville City aforesaid, monthly, on the 20th or before the end of the month of May
1929, and on the 20th or before the end of each month thereafter for twenty successive months, the sum of Twelve & 67/100 (\$12.67)
Dollars, (\$12.67) being the regular monthly installment payable on the eight Shares of Stock and Four & 67/100 (\$4.67)
Dollars, being the monthly interest (the advance or loan) until there have been paid twenty monthly payments, and shall for the next twenty months pay the sum of

Eleven & 600/100 (\$11.73) Dollars, (\$11.73) Dollars, being the regular monthly payment on said stock and Three & 73/100 (\$3.73) Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due);
for the next twenty months the sum of Eight & 33/100 (\$8.33) Dollars, (\$8.33) Dollars, being the regular monthly payment on said stock and Two & 89/100 (\$2.89)
Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due); for the next twenty months pay the sum of nine & 87/100 (\$9.87)
Dollars, (\$9.87) Dollars, being the monthly installment on said shares of stock and

one & 87/100 (\$1.87) Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due); for the next twenty months pay the
sum of Eight & 93/100 (\$8.93) Dollars, (\$8.93) Dollars, being the monthly installment on said shares of stock and
one & 87/100 (\$1.87) Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due.)

Each of the above payments to be made on the 20th or before the 15th day of each month, and shall thereafter surrender to the Company the said eight
shares of stock and the certificate thereof, the amount at such time paid shares by me to be credited as a payment upon the advance or loan made me the said
Carl Fisher

and shall pay or cause to be paid all fines which may be duly imposed upon, or charged against me the said Carl Fisher
note or obligation, and the condition thereunder written, reference being thereunto had will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I the said Carl Fisher
in consideration of the said debt and sum of money as aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said The Carolina Loan and Trust Company,
according to the terms of said note or obligation, and also in consideration of the further sum of Five Dollars to me
the said Carl Fisher

in hand well and truly paid by the said The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, at and before the sealing and delivery of these Presents, (the receipt whereof is hereby
acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents, do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said The Carolina Loan and Trust
Company, all that tract or parcel of land, situated in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, and described as follows:

about two miles north of Greenville Court
House, known as lot no. 30 of the Hammett
Lands, Beginning on the north side of
Pinckney Street, corner of lot no. 31, and
thence running n. 21-10 E. 190 feet, to a ten
foot alley, thence along said alley n. 68-
50 W. 100 feet to the corner of lot no. 29,
thence S. 21-10 W. 190 feet to Pinckney Street
thence S. 68-50 E. along Pinckney Street 100
feet to the beginning corner, said being
the same lot conveyed to me, Carl Fisher
by E. C. Collins, and conveyed to E. C. Collins
by Evelina Collins deed recorded in the
R. M. C. office for Greenville County in
Deed Book 701, at page 133.
