

THE STATE OF SOUTH CAROLINA,

TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN:

I Carrie M Thompson of Greenville, in the County of Greenville, and the State of South Carolina, send Greeting:

WHEREAS, I, Carrie M. Thompson, the said, my certain note or obligation, bearing date the 22nd day of July, 1929

indebted unto The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, of the City and County of Greenville in said State (a body corporate, duly incorporated under the laws of such State), in the sum of Five hundred and \$500.00 Dollars

with interest thereon at the rate of eight per centum per annum, payable monthly from the 22nd day of July, A. D. 1929

according to the provisions of the Charter, By-Laws, Rules and Regulations of the said Company in manner and form following, that is to say, that the said Carrie M. Thompson shall pay or cause to be paid to the said Company, or its certain attorneys, successors or assigns, at Greenville City aforesaid, monthly, on the 20th or before the end of the month of June 1929, and on the 20th or before the end of each month thereafter for twenty successive months, the sum of \$7.92 Dollars

being the regular monthly installment payable on the five and 2/100 Shares of Stock and Two and 2/100 Dollars, being the monthly interest on the advance or loan) until there have been paid twenty monthly payments, and shall for the next twenty months pay the sum of Seven and 3/100 Dollars (\$7.30) Dollars, being the regular monthly payment on said stock and Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due); for the next twenty months the sum of Six and 3/100 Dollars (\$6.30) Dollars, being the regular monthly payment on said stock and Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due); for the next twenty months pay the sum of one and 7/100 Dollars (\$1.75) Dollars, being the monthly installment on said shares of stock and Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due); for the next twenty months pay the sum of Five and 5/100 Dollars (\$5.58) Dollars, being the monthly payment on said shares of stock and Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due.)

Each of the above payments to be made on the 20th or before the last day of each month, and shall thereafter surrender to the Company the said fine shares of stock and the certificate thereof, the amount at such time paid shares by me to be credited as a payment upon the advance or loan made me, the said Carrie M. Thompson

and shall pay or cause to be paid all fines which may be duly imposed upon, or charged against me the said Carrie M. Thompson

in accordance with the Charter, By-Laws, Rules and Regulations, as in and by the said note or obligation, and the condition thereunder written, reference being thereunto had, will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I, Carrie M. Thompson, the said, in consideration of the said debt and sum of money as aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, according to the terms of said note or obligation, and also in consideration of the further sum of Five Dollars to me, the said Carrie M. Thompson

in hand well and truly paid by the said The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, at and before the sealing and delivery of these Presents (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents, do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, all that tract or parcel of land, situated in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, and described as follows:

Lying in the City of Greenville, having the following metes and bounds: Beginning on the west side of Davis Alley, (now known as Clifton Street) at cora Benson's corner, thence running N. 31 E. 53 feet to Elizabeth Smith's Corner; thence N 55 W. 40 feet to Elizabeth Smith's Corner, thence S. 31 W. 53 feet to Cora Benson's line, thence S. 55 E. 40 feet to the beginning corner on said street, and more fully described in the deed made to me, Carrie M. Williams, under my former name of Carrie M. Williams, by Hattie E.
