*I Marshall Ladson*

of Greenville, in the County of Greenville, and the State of South Carolina, send Greeting:

WHEREAS, *I*, the said *Marshall Ladson* in and by *my* certain note or obligation, bearing date the *13th* day of *September* 192*9* indebted unto The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, of the City and County of Greenville, in said State (a body corporate, duly incorporated under the laws of such State), in the sum of *Two Hundred Fifty (\$250.00)* Dollars, with interest thereon at the rate of *eight* per centum per annum, payable monthly from the *13th* day of *September* A. D. 192*9* according to the provisions of the Charter, By-Laws, Rules and Regulations of the said Company, in manner and form following, that is to say, that

*I* the said *Marshall Ladson* shall pay or cause to be paid to the said Company, or its certain attorneys, successors or assigns, at Greenville City aforesaid, monthly, on the 20th or before the end of the month of *October* 192*9*, and on the 20th or before the end of each month thereafter for twenty successive months, the sum of *Three + 98/100 (\$3.98)*

*\$2.50* Dollars, (*two + one half* Shares of Stock and *One + 48/100 (\$1.48)* Dollars, being the regular monthly installment payable on the

*Three + 67/100 (\$3.67)* Dollars, being the monthly interest on the advance or loan) until there have been paid twenty monthly payments, and shall for the next twenty months pay the sum of *Three + 38/100 (\$3.38)* Dollars, (*two + one half* Shares of Stock and *One + 17/100 (\$1.17)* Dollars, being the regular monthly payment on said stock and

*Three + 38/100 (\$3.38)* Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due); for the next twenty months the sum of *Three + 38/100 (\$3.38)* Dollars, (*two + one half* Shares of Stock and *One + 17/100 (\$1.17)* Dollars, being the regular monthly payment on said stock and

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*all my right, title and interest in and to all that certain tract containing five acres, more or less, situate in Greenville Township, on the Old Paris Mountain Road, and being those several lots on the Old Paris Mountain Road described in the deed executed by Ed. Scott to Anna Scott (Ladson) December, 1918, recorded in Deed Book 58, page 20, P. M. C. Office for Greenville County; the said Anna Scott Ladson died intestate in March 1929 and left as her sole heirs at law and distributees the mortgage and Edward Scott. Also; all those certain lots of land situate in Brewertown and being more definitely described in the deeds executed by J. E. Mocks, Trustee, on June 19, 1920 to Marshall and Anna Ladson, the same being recorded in Volume 74, Page 246, and executed by R. Mayr Cleveland, to Anna Ladson, March 8, 1924 and being recorded in Volume 96 Page 223 P. M. C. Office for Greenville County, reference to which deeds is hereby made for a more definite description.*
