All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate,
lying and being in Austin Township, in or near
the Town of Simpsonville, in said County and State
and lying on the Greenville and Laurens Road,
and sometimes known as the "Capitol Highway",

Beginning at an iron pin on the North side of the

sometimes known as the "George League Road", thence a-
long the center of said road, exact distance not known,
to J.O. Gresham's line; thence with J.O. Gresham's line S. 63 W.
(distance, not known) to iron pin, J.O. Gresham's corner on
said Capitol Highway; thence along said highway (dis-
tance not known) to the beginning corner, said cor-
ner containing all the land of the said Paul R. Barton which
lies between the said Capitol Highway and the George
League Road, which amount is estimated to be five
acres, more or less. This is the home place of a tract
