sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of *Ten per cent*

beside all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part

thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being thereunto had, as will more fully appear

or lots of land situate in Greenville Township, County aforesaid known and designated as Lots #30, 31 and 32 of block C, of the City View Subdivision according to plat of same recorded in the office of R.M.C. for Greenville County in Plat Book A, at page 460 and according to said plat described as follows:
Beginning at a point on the east side of Henderson Street, joint corner of lots 32 and 33 and running thence along joint line of said lots S. 89-30 E. 155 feet to point in line of lot 54; thence S. 2-1/2 W. 115 feet, more or less; to a point; thence N. 88 W. 15 feet, more or less to point; thence S. 4-50 E. 37.15 feet more or less to corner of lot 29; thence along line of lots 29 and 30 N. 89-30 W. 140 feet to point on Henderson Street; thence along Henderson Street N. 2-1/2 E. 150 feet to the point of beginning.
