WHEREAS, *Anna Harrison* the said *Maria Harrison*  
in and by *my* certain *promissory* note in writing, of  
even date with these presents, well and truly indebted to

*The Woodside National Bank, of Greenville, S.C.*  
in the full and just sum of *Twelve Thousand Dollars (\$12,000.00)*  
Dollars, to be paid

*with interest thereon, both* at the rate of *Eight* per cent. per annum to be  
computed and paid *periodically in advance*

until paid in full all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal  
or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note, *to become immediately due*, at the option of the holder hereof, who may  
sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney *to be named by the holder hereof* besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be  
added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part  
thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind, all of which is secured under this mortgage; as in and by the said note, reference  
being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That *Maria Harrison* the said *Maria Harrison*  
in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said *The Woodside*  
*National Bank*

according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to *me* the said *Maria Harrison*  
in hand well and truly paid by the said *The Woodside National*  
*Bank*

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant,

bargain, sell and release unto the said **The Woodside National Bank, its successors and assigns: All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land, lying and being situate in Fairview Township, County and State aforesaid, and more particularly described, as follows: Beginning at a point marking the extreme southwesterly corner of the within described tract, which point marks corner with Tract No. 1 and land now or formerly owned by Templeton Jenkins, and which point is in center of the Jenkins Bridge Road; thence along line of Tract No. 1, N. 43-3/4 W. 54 chains to a stone; thence N. 1-1/2 W. 6.42 chains to a point in the center of Cripple Creek; thence along center of said Cripple Creek as the same meanders in a general northeasterly direction 40 chains, more or less, to a point; thence leaving said creek S. 61 E. 41.20 chains to a stone; thence S. 5-1/2 E. 29.72 chains to a point in the center of said Jenkins Bridge Road; thence along the center of said road, as the same meanders in a westerly direction, 30 chains, more or less, to the point and place of beginning, said tract being a portion of Tract No. 2, and containing 216 acres, according to a survey made by J.N. Southern, D.S., under date of February 20, 1893, and being the same property conveyed to S.E. Harrison by Henry Harrison, January 1st, 1920, by deed recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, in Vol. 48, page 93, this being the same tract of land conveyed to me this day by Fannie C. Scott, Judge of Probate.**

It is understood that this mortgage is junior to mortgages in favor of Prudential Life Insurance Company and Southern Bond & Mortgage Company. This mortgage is given as additional security to Note and mortgage this day executed to The Woodside National Bank in the sum of \$12,000.00.
