SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, *I*, the said *Joe Williams*
in and by *my* certain *promissory* note, in writing, of
even date with these presents, *am* well and truly indebted to

in the full and just sum of *one hundred sixty-nine (\$169.00)*
Dollars, to be paid *one year from date*

with interest thereon, from *date* at the rate of *8* per cent. per annum to be
computed and paid *date* FULLY AND THE LIEN OF THIS INSTRUMENT
is satisfied this *March 26th* *1929* DAY

interest be at any time past due and *is* paid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may
sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of *\$25.00*
OF *Sda Staley*

added to the amount due on said note to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part
thereof, be collected by an attorney by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference
being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That *Joe Williams*
in consideration of the said debt and sum of money *at 5:10 P.M.* and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said *Sda Staley*

according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to *me* the said
Joe Williams
in hand well and truly paid by the said *Sda Staley*

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bar-
gain, sell and release unto the said *Sda Staley, her heirs and assigns:*

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Green-
ville township, Greenville county, State of
South Carolina, lying in the city of Green-
ville, and being lots nos. 1, 2 and 3 on plat
of the same made by R. C. Dalton, December, 1912,
and having the following metes and bounds,
to-wit:

Beginning on an iron spike on the
northwest side of an unnamed street, corner
of Tom Davis, and running thence with said
street N. 41 E. 182 feet to an iron spike, corner of
Tom Davis; thence with line of Tom Davis
N. 78. 15 W. 63. 1 feet to a branch; thence with
said branch following the meanderings approx-
imately S. 56. 53 W. 140. 4 feet, more or less
thence S. 50. 07 E. 95. 7 feet to the beginning corner
and being the same as conveyed to me
by Sda Staley by her deed of October 12, 1928,
deed not yet recorded.
