Dollars, to be paid on the 16th day of January A.D. 1930

with interest thereon, from Date, ²³ 23 at the rate of 8 per cent. per annum to be
computed and paid ^{annually} annually

until paid in full all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may
sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of \$50.00 besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be
added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, or the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part
thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference
being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bar-
gain, sell and release unto the said Dr. A. White, his heirs and assigns

forever:
All that certain piece, parcel or tract of
land situated, lying and being in Highland
Township, Greenville County, State of South
Carolina, on the left bank of Cannon Branch,
waters of South Tyger River, and has the
following metes and bounds, to wit:
Beginning at a stake in the center of
Cannon Branch at the crossing of the Camp
Creek Road; thence up and with the meander-
ings of said branch to a stake on David
Cannon's line; thence N. 83 1/2 W. 17 chs to a stone;
thence S. 26 1/2 E. 4.60 chs to the Camp Creek Road;
thence along said road S. 85 1/2 E. 7.00 chs to
an angle in road; thence S. 78 1/2 E. 5.85 chs to
an angle in road; thence S. 30 1/2 E. 1.00 ch
to an angle in the road; thence S. 70 E.
3.00 chs to an angle in road; thence S. 42 E.
4.12 chs to the beginning corner, containing
seven (7) acres, more or less, and being the
same tract of land conveyed to me by
