I, John A. Bouchillon

SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, *I*, the said *John A. Bouchillon*
in and by *my* certain *promissory* note, in writing, of
even date with these presents, *am* well and truly indebted to

S. H. Reames
in the full and just sum of *Two Thousand*
Dollars, to be paid *One year from date*

with interest thereon, from *the date* at the rate of *16 64* per cent. per annum to be
computed and paid *as usual*

until paid in full, all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may
sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of *Ten per cent*

besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be
added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part
thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference
being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That *I*, the said *John A. Bouchillon*
in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said

S. H. Reames
according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to *me*, the said

John A. Bouchillon
in hand well and truly paid by the said

S. H. Reames
at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bar-
gain, sell and release unto the said *S. H. Reames*

All that certain piece, parcel, or lot of land
situate lying and being in the County of
Greenville State aforesaid, in Gantt Township
on the east side of the Southern Railway
(formerly known as C & G. Railroad) between
Greenville S. C. and Piedmont S. C., and being
more fully described as follows:

Beginning at a point at the intersection
of the Southern Railway property and a
cross country road, which runs from the
Gantt school house to the White Horse Road,
and running along the center of said
road East to the Fuller line, thence north
along the line of the Fuller property 385
feet to an iron pin; thence in a northeastern
direction 915 feet to an iron pin adjoining
the Southern Railway property; thence along
the Southern Railway property to the begin-
ning point, same being known as tract
#8 as shown by a plat of the C. C. Good
property near Gantt Station, and containing
six acres, more or less, said plat being
recorded in Plat Book 9 at page 223.

Being the same lot of land conveyed to
John A. Bouchillon by C. C. Good on December
31st, 1928.
