Dollars, to be paid *as follows: \$200.00 July 14, 1929; \$500.00 Jan. 14, 1930; \$200.00 July 14, 1930; \$200.00 Jan. 14, 1931; and \$500.00 Jan. 14, 1932.*

with interest thereon, from *date* at the rate of *7* percent per annum to be
computed and paid *semi-annually*

until paid in full all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may
sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of *Seven Per Cent*

besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be
added to the amount due on said note to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part
thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference
being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said *Liberty*

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bar-
gain, sell and release unto the said *The Liberty Life Insurance Company*, the following described property:

aforesaid, being known and designated as Lot #2 of the Parrish, Gower and Martin property as
Lot #2 of the Parrish, Gower and Martin Property as shown by plat of same recorded in the
R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book G, at page 197 and according to said plat
more particularly described as follows: Beginning at an iron pin on the west side of McDaniel
Ave. at joint corner of lots 1 and 2, which iron pin is 66.5 feet north of the intersection of
McDaniel Ave. and Watts Ave., and running thence along line of McDaniel Ave. N. 4-22 E. 66.5
feet to an iron pin, joint corner of lots 2 and 3; thence along joint line of said lot N.
85-38 W. 187 feet to iron pin in line of lot 27; thence along the joint line of lots 27 and 2,
