thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference

gain, sell and release unto the said Jno C. Henry, his heirs and assigns

forever
all that certain piece, parcel or tract of
land in Butler Township, Greenville County
South Carolina, and having the following
metes and bounds, to-wit: Beginning from
a stone in Rocky Creek (water oak witness),
and running thence N. 68 3/4 W. 7.90 to stone
at a ranch, thence N. 15 1/2 W. 10.42 to an iron
pin; thence S. 42 1/2 W. 21.27 to iron pin, (Alice
Forester's line), thence S. 42 E. 16.50 to small
poplar at creek, thence down meanders of
said creek N. 44 E. 20.75 to the beginning of
