SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, *I*, the said *J. L. Aiken, an unmarried man*

in and by *my* certain promissory note in writing, of even date with these presents *am* well and truly indebted to AMERICAN BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, a corporation incorporated under the laws of the State of South Carolina, in the full and just sum of *Nine Hundred no/1.00* Dollars,
