All that tract or parcel of land situate in the County of Greenville, Carol Mountain Township, State of South Carolina, and described as follows: Beginning at an iron pin on the east side of Buncombe Road, corner of lands of Mrs. Ida Stadd, and running thence with the Buncombe Road 144 ft. 7 in. to an iron pin, corner of Mrs. Johnson's land; thence 190 ft. in an easterly direction to an iron pin; thence along the line of Mrs. Stadd in a southerly direction 119 ft to an iron pin; thence in a westerly direction along the line of Mrs. Ida Stadd 150 ft. to the beginning corner.
