Lee Poole,

in hand well and truly paid by the said PIEDMONT SAVINGS AND TRUST COMPANY, at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents, do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said PIEDMONT SAVINGS AND TRUST COMPANY, all that tract or parcel of land, situated in County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, and described as follows:

Said [blank] has a five-room house thereon designated as #118 on city maps in Block 1 and has a frontage on the North side of Sullivan Street of 44'10 feet and a depth of 122 feet. This is the same lot which was conveyed to J. L. Milford to J. G. O. League by his deed dated February 15, 1921 and recorded in deed book 70, page 240, P. M. L. Records for Greenville County. This lot is bounded by the lot owned by me and by lot owned by [blank] and this is one of the lots which was conveyed to me, by M. O.
