WHEREAS, *I* the said *Joe I. Williams*

well and truly indebted to PIEDMONT SAVINGS AND TRUST COMPANY of Greenville, State and County aforesaid, (a corporation duly chartered under and by virtue of the laws of said State) in and by

certain promissory note in writing, dated *Dec 24, 1932* and given for *One Thousand* (\$1000.00) Dollars, payable *one year from date*

with interest from *date* at the rate of *3 1/2* per cent, per annum, payable *semi-annually*

and further providing for collection and attorney's fees in case of foreclosure or collection through an attorney. reference being had thereto will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That *I* the said *Joe I. Williams*

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money as aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said PIEDMONT SAVINGS AND TRUST COMPANY, according to the condition of the said note or obligation, and also in consideration of the further sum of FIVE DOLLARS, to *me* the said *Joe I. Williams*

in hand well and truly paid by the said PIEDMONT SAVINGS AND TRUST COMPANY, at and before the sealing and delivery of these Presents, (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents, do grant, bargain, sell, and release unto the said PIEDMONT SAVINGS AND TRUST COMPANY, all that tract or parcel of land, situated in County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, and described as follows:

situate on the south side of Pendleton Street, known as Lot no 2 on a plat of land formerly owned by Sarah McRee Williams, located south of Pendleton Street, East of Menninger Street, and North of Garlington Streets made by W. A. Hudson October 2, 1905 and more particularly described by meter and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the south side of Pendleton Street 100.3 feet from corner of Menninger Street (S.E. corner); thence with Pendleton Street S. 71 1/2 E. 100.3 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 19 1/4 E. 193 feet to an iron pin in alley; thence with north line of said alley N. 71 1/2 W. 100.3 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 18 1/2 E. 193 feet to the beginning corner. Being the same lot of land conveyed to me by V. McRee Williams by deed dated April 11, 1908 and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Vol 42424 at page 556.
