All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, situate, lying and being in the State and County aforesaid, near the Buncombe Road and having the following metes and bounds to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin two hundred seven and four tenths (207.4) feet N. 87 degrees 40 minutes E. from Buncombe Road, being the second bench mark referred to in deed from Union Bleaching and Finishing Company to J. St. Styles dated Dec 21, 1912; thence N. 87 degrees 40 minutes E. two hundred seven and four tenths (207.4) feet to an iron pin; thence N. 4 degrees 17 minutes W. one hundred and five (105) feet to an iron pin; thence S. 87 degrees 40 minutes W. two hundred seven and four tenths (207.4) feet to an iron pin located in the Styles line already referred to; thence S. 4 degrees 17 minutes E. one hundred and five (105) feet to the beginning corner, containing one half (1/2) acre, more or less, being the same tract of land conveyed to me by Union Bleaching & Finishing Co., by deed dated the 3rd day of November, 1919, and recorded in the R.
