grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said *B. C. Woods*

All that piece, parcel or tract of land
situate lying and being in the State and
County aforesaid on waters of Meadow Fork,
waters of Mush Creek, and in Saluda
Township, and has the following metes and
bounds:

Beginning at a chestnut near Bensons
place; thence with said line to stone corner
on Mill Creek; thence up creek to stone corner
in said creek; thence north to Henry Pitman's
stone corner; thence along Henry Pitman's line
north to a bend in road on stone corner;
thence along road north to J. St. Rois stone
corner; thence south west along Rois line to
rock shoals corner on white oak on branch;
thence south along branch to creek; thence north
west along creek to J. P. Pitman's, rock corner;
thence south west along J. P. Pitman's line to
C. A. Fowler's stone corner, thence southwest
with Fowler's line to a stone corner on south
