all that tract or lot of land in *Greenville* Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.

*In the city of Greenville, on the south side of Nichols Street, near the C. & S. Railroad, containing 29/100 of an acre, more or less, and having the following metes and bounds: Beginning at a stone on the south side of Nichols Street, A. B. Davis' corner, and running thence S. 26 3/4 N. 226 feet to a stake; thence S. 63 1/2 feet to a stake; thence N. 26 3/4 E. 229 feet to a stake on Nichols Street; thence with Nichols Street N. 78 1/4 N. 56 feet to the beginning corner, bounded on the north by Nichols Street and on the south, east and west by lands of A. B. Davis.*
