computed and paid annually, until paid in full all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of \$10.00

besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on the said note to be collectible as a part theron; if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

"all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Chick Springs township and in the state and county aforesaid and in the town of Laylors, on the east side of public road leading to Brushy Creek across land of W. C. Stepp, Sam Smith and other lands of C. S. Hammatt and having the following dimensions: Beginning on an I-P on the said Brushy Creek road 100 feet below west Rains' corner and on corner of W. C. Stepp's lot; thence down said road 50 feet to I-P; thence back in an easterly direction 2 1/3 feet to I-P; thence in northerly direction 50 feet to I-P; thence with line of W. C.
