WHEREAS, *D*, the said *Lindsey W. Young*  
in and by *my* certain *promissory* note in writing, of  
even date with these presents, *and* well and truly indebted to

*P. B. Greesham*  
in the full and just sum of *twelve hundred, fifty and 00/100*  
Dollars, to be paid *December 1st, 1935*

with interest thereon, from *maturity* at the rate of *eight* per cent. per annum to be  
computed and paid *annually*

until paid in full all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal  
or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may  
sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of *seven per cent.*

besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be  
added to the amount due on the said note to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part  
thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being  
thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said

according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of *Three* Dollars, to *me # 2974*, the said

in hand well and truly paid by the said *P. B. Greesham*

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released and by these Presents do grant, bar-  
gain, sell and release unto the said *P. B. Greesham, his heirs and assigns:*

all that certain tract or parcel of land  
lying, being and situated in *State and*  
County of *Greenville* - aforesaid, the same being a part  
of a tract conveyed to me by the deed of  
*Tarver Fullen* on the *22nd* day of *February*  
*1918* and recorded in office of *P. M. C.* for  
*Greenville County* April *11th* *1918* in *Vol 33*  
*page 227* and being more fully described  
as follows.

Beginning on stone on road; thence due  
West *12.00* ch to stone; thence *S 20 W. 13.00* to  
stone; thence due W. *13.00* to stone; thence  
*S 21 1/2 E. 15.90* to stone on *Georgia road*; thence  
*N. 48 1/2 E. 9.06* to stone *running in 7476 305 to stone*; thence *S. 75 E. 2.20* to  
stone; thence *N. 23 E. 10.00* to  
thence *N. 20 1/2 E. 20* to the beginning corner,  
and containing *forty-four and three-fourths*  
*(44 3/4)* acres, more or less and bounded by  
lands of now or formerly owned by  
*P. B. Harrison, B. W. Young, Annum Fullen*
