Privilege is given to make additional payments on the principal sum of this note in sums of \$100.00 or multiples thereof, on any interest maturity date.

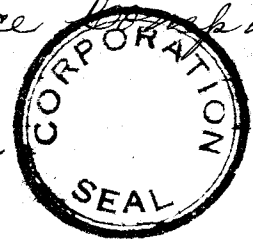
South Carolina Release
